

13TH INTERNATIONAL FRYDERYK CHOPIN PIANO COMPETITION IN MARIÁNSKÉ LÁZNĚ

Czech Republic, 8 - 12 August 2022

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Competition Date and Venue

The 13th International Fryderyk Chopin Piano Competition will take place between 8-12 August 2022 in Mariánské Lázně

Organiser

The competition is organized by the Fryderyk Chopin Society of the Czech Republic and the Town of Mariánské Lázně.

Categories

The competition is divided into two categories:

I. participants up to 19 years of age (born on 9th August 2003 and later)

II. participants up to 30 years of age (born on 8th August 1992 and later)

Competition Scoring

The competition scoring is open to the public. Complete results, including the scoring of each member of the jury, will be announced after each round.

Practice

There will be pianos available to the contestants for practising.

Application and Registration Fee

The completed application forms together with the required attachments are to be sent by the participants by **15 May 2022** at the latest to the following address:

The organiser shall confirm the receipt of the application and announce the exact date of the performance by 15 June 2022.

CATEGORY I: EUR 40 / CZK 1,000

CATEGORY II: **EUR 80 (CZK 2,000)** This fee is to be paid to the account No. 8863420277/0100 (Komerční banka Mariánské Lázně, swift KOMBCZPPXXX, IBAN CZ1601000000008863420277).

When paying the registration fee, Czech contestants shall use their birth certificate number, whereas foreign contestants their passport number as the variable symbol.

Accommodation and Travel Expenses

While participating in the competition, all the contestants will be provided with accommodation free of charge. Travel expenses are to be paid by the contestants.

All the pieces of the competition repertoire must be played by heart. The contestants are to perform the following pieces by Fryderyk Chopin:

Category I

Only one competition round – free choice of a F. Chopin's 20-25 minutes composition

Category II

3 competition rounds

1st round:

1) One of the following compositions:

Ballade in G minor, Op. 23 Ballade in F major, Op. 38 Ballade in A flat major, Op. 47 Ballade in F minor, Op. 52 Barcarolle in F sharp major, Op. 60

2) One etude of the following:

Op. 10 No. 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 Op. 25 No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12

3) One Nocturne

2nd round

Free choice of a F. Chopin's 30-35 minutes composition
The programme may not include the compositions performed in the first round.

3rd round with the orchestra

One of F. Chopin's concertos: E minor, Op. 11 F minor, Op. 21

The winners will receive an invitation to perform in the recital at the Chopin Festival 2023, a concert at the Embassy of Poland in Prague as well as an invitation to perform in a concert with the Orchestra of Mariánské Lázně. The prize winners who fail to participate in the concert of the winners (12 August 2022) will not receive the financial award.

The jury has the right not to award any of the prizes.

If several identical prizes are awarded in the same category, the jury has the right to put together the total amount assigned for the respective category and distribute it in a way respecting the competition result. The jury's decision is final.

The jury of the 13th International Fryderyk Chopin Piano Competition consists of distinguished pianists and piano teachers from the Czech Republic and abroad. The chairman of the jury is prof. Ivan Klánský.
